

Understanding Your Results – T Level Technical Qualifications

Introduction

In the Spring and Summer each year Providers will receive results from the Autumn and Summer series of T Level assessments. This could include results from Core Employer Set Project (ESP), Core Exams, the Occupational Specialism, or a combination of all of these depending on where students are on their T Level qualification.

This document is aimed at supporting Providers in understanding what results are available, where they can be accessed, and how to understand them.

How to access results

Results will be available within our Portal for providers on a date set out in our Key Dates Schedule ([found on our website](#)), and guidance on how to log in, and how to access the results information can be found in our [T Level System User Guide](#).

Results are released to Providers within the Portal the day before Providers can share them with students. These dates can be found in the Key Dates Schedule.

Within the Portal, users can access two key documents to see and contextualise results; the **Students Results Slip**, and the **Results Confirmation Report**.

- **Students Results Slip**
 - This shows student achievement within each attempted series, showing raw marks and grade for each sub-component for the Core Component, or raw marks and grade for the OS
 - This is available at a learner and series level
 - This can be downloaded for each series attempted.

- **Results Confirmation Report**

- This shows a breakdown of all students within a cohort who have completed both the Core Employer Set Project and the Core Exam, showing the sub-component Uniform Mark Scale¹ (UMS), overall UMS and overall grade for the core component as a whole, showing the highest achievement by sub-component from all attempts.

Student Results Slip

Core Component

The Core Component is made up of two sub-components: the **Core Employer Set Project**, and the **Core Exam**. The Core Exam sub-component contains two exam papers which must be completed in the same series and combine to give the Core Exam sub-component result, and the Core Employer Set Project sub-component is a single project.

The student results slip for each series will show results for each sub-component a student was booked onto. This could be the Core Employer Set Project, Core Exams, or both.

Results for each Core sub-component will show:

- assessment
- unique paper code
- raw marks achieved (and maximum available raw marks)
- sub-component UMS
- sub-component grade.

¹ The Core Component is modular, meaning students may resit sub-components across series. Assessments may vary slightly in levels of difficulty and, therefore, the mark that represented a certain grade in the external examination in one series may not be appropriate in another series.

To address this, we convert raw marks to uniform marks. The uniform mark scale (UMS) also allows us to account for the relative weighting of the assessment to the qualification as a whole. The maximum UMS points available for each assessment, and the UMS points relating to each grade boundary, are fixed, and can be found in the relevant qualification specification.

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For the Core Exams, the raw mark for each paper will be shown, and a total sub-component mark, UMS, and sub-component grade.

The final section of the Core Component results slip will show the overall Core Component result of overall UMS and overall grade. This section will show the best Core Component result available, aggregated from all available sub-component results, including any from a previous attempt.

Other results status or signifiers are as follows:

DNA	Did Not Attend. The student had a booking but was absent from the assessment
DQ	Disqualified
Unclassified	The student fell below the minimum standard for achievement
#	When against the overall Core Component result, this denotes where a student was absent or disqualified from either the Core Employer Set Project, or one of the papers on the Core Exam

Occupational Specialist Component

The results slip for each series will show results for each assignment within an Occupational Specialist.

Results for each Occupational Specialist assignment will show:

- assessment
- unique paper code
- raw mark and total raw mark available.

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The final section of the results slip will show the Occupational Specialist Component overall result, showing an overall scaled mark, and an overall grade.

The results for each Occupational Specialist Component are not combined across series therefore the results slip this will only ever show the overall result for the series of that booking.

Within some Occupational Specialist Components there may be a moderated assignment. Following the moderation activity and the outcome of quality checks, the provider will receive confirmation of the outcome on the **Results Confirmation Report**.

For T Level Technical Qualification in Education and Childcare: Early Years Educator occupational specialism only, assignment 2 has 2 parts: EYE P1 this will show a grade of **achieved** or **not yet achieved (NYA)**, and for EYEP2 and AT (Assisting Teaching) the final mark for assignment 2 will be the combined mark for all 3 structured observations.

Post-Results Services

On the date of results release to students the papers and mark schemes of the relevant series will be made available on our website, to allow for review and use in preparation for future series.

To help providers understand wider themes and student performance, after each series we publish a Chief Moderator Report and a Chief Examiner report, which provides the grade boundaries, as well as a narrative on general student achievement, and any other noteworthy comments and suggestions to support providers in preparing students for future series.

If results received are outside of your reasonable expectations for a student, you can find our range of post-results services available on our website, allowing providers to request:

- a clerical check (*an administrative check of marks to ensure they were recorded and processed correctly*)
- a review of marking (*a review by the Chief Examiner of the original examiner marking to ensure it was accurate*)
- a review of moderations (*a review by the Chief Moderator of moderated marks, where applicable, to ensure moderation was accurate. This must be requested at cohort level, and cannot be requested for individual learners within a cohort*)
- access to scripts (*to allow a provider to receive a copy of a marked student paper*).
