### **Technical change to 16-19 maths and English condition of funding guidance**

The ESFA has made a change to the 2019-20 16-19 maths and English condition of funding guidance. Learners with a grade 2 or below can study towards a pass in Level 2 Functional Skills or a GCSE grade 9 to 4 to meet the condition of funding.
