Step 1

Step 2

We will provide the school with vouchers to download and access Peer Tutor on your behalf.



Step 3

Students download the app and enter the voucher code.



Step 4

We credit the students' accounts with a supply of gems each month to spend on live tutoring sessions, work feedback and Q&As.



Step 5

We will send you in-depth monthly reports on students' usage and progress so you can see the impact your sponsorship is making.

If your organisation relies on government funding, we can support you in demonstrating your social value when bidding for contracts in terms of how the funding is being used to enrich peoples' lives.


