1	Is NCFE developing Digital T Levels?	<p>NCFE has been awarded the contract to develop the technical qualifications for the following 2 T Levels:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Digital Support Services</li> <li>• Digital Business Services.</li> </ul> <p>These Level 3 technical qualifications will provide learners with the knowledge, skills and behaviours needed to progress into skilled employment or higher level technical training or study in the digital sector. The core knowledge and understanding will be assessed through an examination and core skills through a practical employer-set project. In addition to this, maths, English and general digital skills will be integrated within the qualification in occupationally relevant contexts.</p>
2	What are the occupational specialisms available?	<p>The specialisms for the Digital Support Services T Level are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Digital Infrastructure</li> <li>• Network cabling</li> <li>• Digital Support</li> </ul> <p>The specialism in the Digital Business Services T Level is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Data Technician</li> </ul>

3	When will these Digital T Levels be available for delivery?	<p>From September 2021, the Digital Support Services T Level and Digital Business Services T Level will be rolled out for delivery by Wave 1 and Wave 2 providers. See a list of approved <a href="#">Wave 1 and 2 T Level providers</a>.</p> <p>By 2022, the Digital T Level will be available for delivery by all providers that want to and meet the criteria. By 2024 it is expected that the vast majority of providers will be delivering this T Level.</p>
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
