NCFE Level 3 Certificate in Creative Craft (603/3253/0)

Qualification content, structure and outcomes

This qualification is designed to extend your skills in craft to an advanced level. It'll improve your creative and intellectual ability in communication, innovation and critical evaluation, and extend your understanding of health and safety issues.

This qualification will:

- focus on the study of creative crafts
- offer breadth and depth of study, incorporating a key core of knowledge
- provide opportunities to acquire a number of practical and technical skills.

To achieve this qualification, you'll need to complete 4 mandatory units:

The following pathways are available for this qualification:

- Art and Design (ART)
- Heritage and Traditional Crafts (HTC)
- Textiles (TEX)
- Construction (CON)
- Floristry (FLO)
- Cake Decoration (CAK)
- Cookery (COO)

Learners can complete either a generic Creative Craft qualification or one of the above pathways.

There are no optional units.
