Entry is at the discretion of the centre. However, learners should be aged 19 or above to undertake this qualification.		

## About this qualification

This qualification will provide learners with an opportunity to develop an understanding of adverse childhood experiences relevant to their current or future roles and will equip them with basic techniques for preventing and addressing adverse childhood experiences in practice.

## Qualification structure

To be awarded this qualification, learners are required to successfully complete 3 mandatory units.

### Mandatory units

Unit 01 Exploring childhood and family structures
Unit 02 Introduction to adverse childhood experiences
Unit 03 Understand strategies to improve outcomes for children affected by adverse childhood experiences

## Assessment

This is a knowledge-based qualification with an internally assessed and externally assured portfolio of evidence.

## Progression opportunities

The objectives of the qualification are to enable learners to:

- explore childhood and family structures
- explore adverse childhood experiences and understand potential outcomes for children enduring adverse childhood experiences
- understand the role of the practitioner supporting children impacted by adverse childhood experiences
- develop strategies to improve outcomes for children affected by adverse childhood experiences

Learners who achieve this qualification could progress to:

- Level 2 Award in an Introduction to Neuroscience in the Early Years
- Level 4 Certificate in Neuroscience in Early Years
- Level 2 Diploma for the Early Years Practitioner
- Level 3 Diploma for the Early Years Workforce (Early Years Educator)
