
Performance tables quick guide

Where do Technical Awards fit in the performance tables?

V Cert Technical Awards are a suite of high quality technical qualifications which count in the 'open group' of the Progress 8 measure.

How do V Cert Technical Awards measure up to GCSEs?

V Cert Technical Awards are designed as technical alternatives to GCSEs. Below you can see how our V Cert grading equates to GCSE grading.

Why did you remove the L1D* grade?

This grade was removed to help decompress the lower L1 grade boundaries.

Claiming points for qualifications with the same discount code

In the event that a learner has undertaken 2 qualifications with the same discount code, for example GSCE in Physical Education and the NCFE Level 1/2 Technical Award in Sports Studies, then the school will only be able to apply for the performance points for the qualification where the examination has been taken first.

In cases where exams in the same subject are scheduled for different days in the same series, only the qualification with the earlier exam counts in performance measures. In cases where qualifications have no formal examination date, the certification date or coursework deadline date is used as the examination date.







Performance tables FAQs (continued)

What is replacing the legacy Level 1/2 Technical Award in Art and Design?

The legacy Level 1/2 Technical Award in Art and Design (603/2964/6) will expire on 31/12/2022 and this is the last date we can accept learner registrations. Our new Level 1/2 Technical Award in Creative Design and Production (603/7003/8) is a close match, and is approved for performance tables in 2024, 2025 and 2026.

What is replacing the legacy Level 1/2 Technical Award in Performance Skills?

The current L1/2 Performance Skills V Cert will still carry performance points until 2023, however this qualification will be withdrawn from any new registrations in January 2023.

Our Performance Skills certificates will still be available at Level 1 and Level 2. These are a similar size to GCSEs and are internally assessed and externally quality assured. While they are appropriate and funded for KS4 learners, these do not carry performance points.

Non-point carrying qualifications

We offer a number of qualifications, such as RSHE and Uniformed Services, which are not approved by the DfE to carry performance points, but are still funded for 14-16 learners. You may still wish to offer these qualifications to pupils with specific learning needs, but they will not count towards your progress 8 measures.

2022 and 2023 performance tables

Our legacy V Certs will expire on 31/12/2022 and this is the last date we can accept learner registrations. The last date for certificate claims is 31/12/2024.

2024 performance tables onwards

Our suite of new V Cert qualifications went live for first teach in September 2022, and have replaced the legacy V Certs. The first live assessments will take place in the 2023/24 session.
