Qualification content, structure and outcomes

The purpose of the NCFE Level 3 Diploma in Management Skills and Knowledge is to provide the knowledge, understanding and skills required to work as a team leader/supervisor. This qualification has been aligned to the Team Leader/Supervisor apprenticeship standard.

The qualification consists of 9 mandatory units:

- Unit 01 Leading people
- Unit 02 Communication
- Unit 03 Managing people
- Unit 04 Building relationships
- Unit 05 Operational management
- Unit 06 Project management
- Unit 07 Managing finance
- Unit 08 Self-awareness and continuous development
- Unit 09 Decision making

This qualification has 150 guided learning hours. You need to complete all 9 mandatory units (37 credits) to achieve this qualification.

Similar qualifications

We also offer the following similar qualification:

NCFE Level 3 Diploma in Management (601/4032/X)

This is a combined knowledge and competence based element of the Advanced Apprenticeship in Management. This qualification is 284 guided learning hours and 55 credits. To achieve this qualification you would be required to complete 5 mandatory units (31 credits) and 17 credits from the optional units.
