Qualification	<u>NCFE CACHE Level 3 Diploma in Healthcare Support (610/2160/X)</u>
Summary of amendment	<p>We are pleased to share the addition of the new Diagnostic Imaging Support option to the NCFE CACHE Level 3 Diploma in Healthcare Support (610/2160/X).</p> <p>The primary objective of the Level 3 Diploma in Healthcare Support is to provide learners with knowledge and skills required to work in a range of healthcare support settings. The new Diagnostic Imaging Support option aligns to the occupational option within the Senior Healthcare Support Worker apprenticeship standard. It aims to provide learners with the knowledge and skills required to work as a diagnostic imaging support worker. New content areas of both knowledge and skills developed to support this option include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • prepare medicines and monitor their effects on individuals during radiological procedures • understand the administration of medicines for radiological procedures • perform intravenous cannulation for radiological procedures • support individuals to participate in their own healthcare activities to enable radiological procedures • support the team to facilitate radiological procedures • principles of anatomy, physiology and physics for radiological procedures • managing digital radiographic images (this was previously AN99) • assist in assuring the effective functioning of the radiographic image quality assurance programme (this was previously AN100) <p>This new option is appropriate for learners who are already working within healthcare or who wish to progress to employment as a diagnostic imaging support worker within healthcare and would be applicable for centres who wish to offer (or are currently offering) the Level 3 Diploma in Healthcare Support.</p> <p>Please note, two units from the Adult Nursing Support optional unit group (AN99 and AN100) have now been moved to the Diagnostic Imaging Support optional unit group as these units are more applicable to this new pathway (indicated in list above).</p>
